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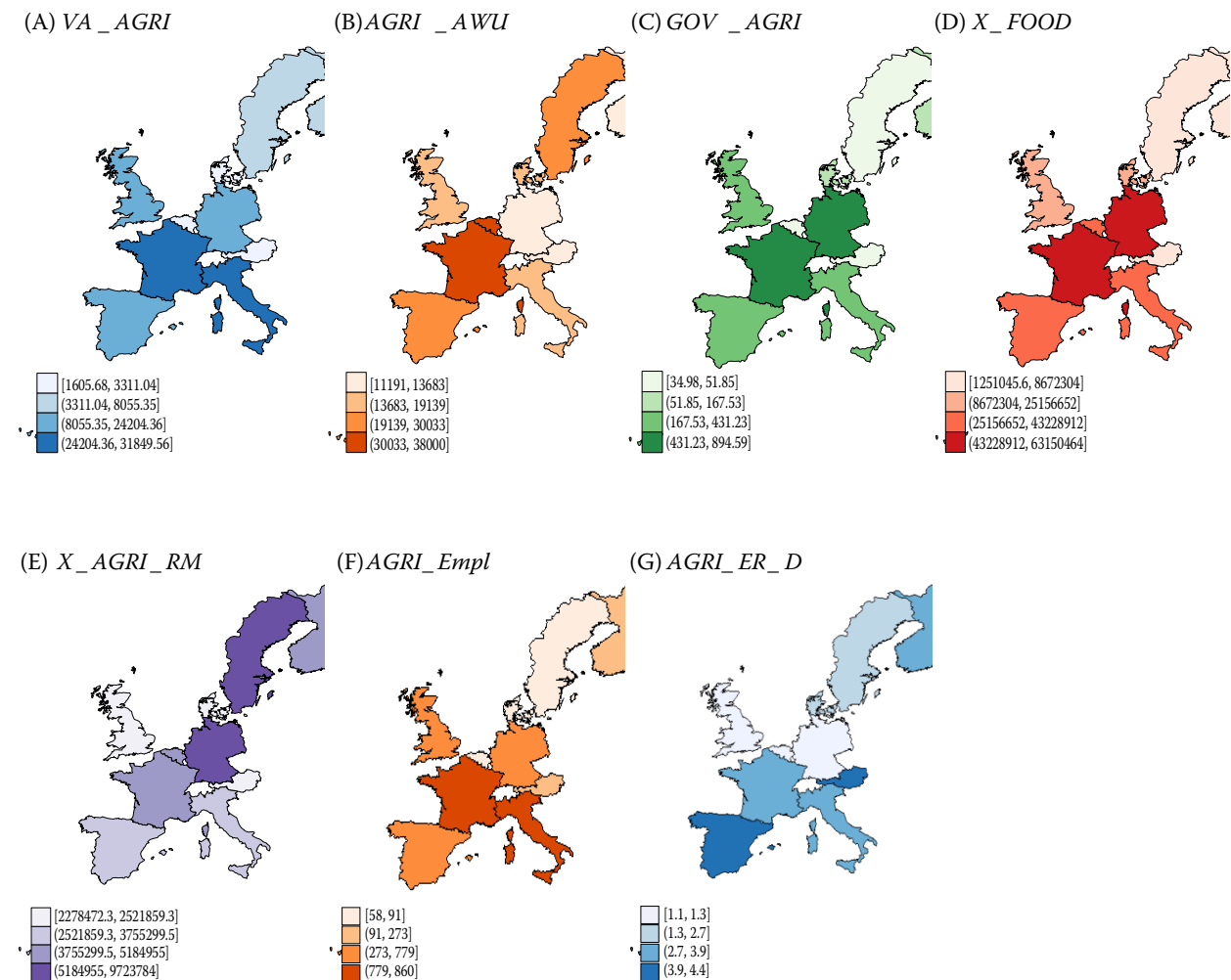


Figure S1. Agricultural indicators in 2016 for EU-10 Member States
